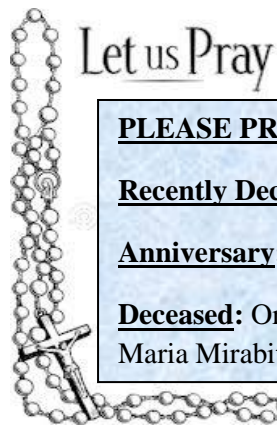
ENTRANCE If you, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But with you is found forgiveness, O God of Israel.

SACRAMENT OF FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2020 This Sacrament will be celebrated on the **weekend of Saturday 21st and Sunday 22nd November 2020**. It is available to all children in Year 3 or above who have been baptised and have received the sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession). If you wish your child to make this Sacrament and did not come to the enrolment night last year you **MUST** attend the first lesson for this program on **Saturday 24th October 2020 commencing at 4.15p.m. You must bring a copy of your child's Baptism and Birth certificate with you to attach to the enrolment form.** Children will participate in lessons in the **St. Joachim Parish Hall. There will not be parent talks this year due to Covid 19 restrictions.** This is the last opportunity for you to enrol for 2020. **NOTE: If you will be enrolling at the first lesson, then please arrive at 3.45pm** to complete the paperwork. The program fee of \$25 is also payable at the first lesson. Thank you.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to Covid 19 restrictions, there will be **no make-up lesson this year. Children will need**

to attend all lessons to make the Sacrament.

In today's second reading, St. Paul thanks the Philippians for being willing to share in his hardships and promises that God, in turn, will fully supply all their needs. Our God truly cannot be outdone in generosity!

MASS UPDATE AND RELATED MATTERS There is currently a limit of 100 people able to gather in places of Religious worship, including for Mass, weddings, and funerals. The "one person per four square meter rule" with 1.5meter social distancing applies, and **registration is required beforehand.** Go to the parish website, www.olhcrosemeadow.org.au and click the **Register for Mass** button and then follow the prompts to whichever Mass you want to attend and complete the details. Please remember to sit **ONLY ON THE MARKED GREEN SPOTS even if you are living in the one household**, to ensure 1.5meter social distancing between ALL parishioners. In Summary:

- **All registrations are online.** We will be printing a list, so **you do not need to print your ticket.**
- Please **ONLY phone the parish office if you do not have online access.** Thank you.
- **Online registration will close at 3pm the previous day for weekday Masses, and 3pm on Saturday for the Vigil and Sunday Masses.**
- **Temperature will be taken** as well as other protocols and health requirements, so please **arrive at least 15 minutes before the start of Mass.** Once Mass starts, the doors will be closed.
- **FACE MASKS** are not compulsory but are highly recommended to be worn.
- After Mass please take a disinfectant wipe (provided on each pew) to rub over surfaces where you have been sitting or come in contact with and place them in the bins provided as you leave.
- **Social gatherings after Religious Services is not permitted.** Please **do not gather outside the church after Mass.** Unfortunately, we must leave immediately upon exiting the church.
- Please note that **toilets will NOT be open.**
- **HOTSPOTS:** If you have attended any of the hotspots listed on the notice in the foyer, you must immediately self-isolate for 14 days and get tested even if you have no symptoms.

May I also take this opportunity to remind you of the following matters please:

- Thank you for your understanding and support regarding Collections. Since we can no longer use the collection plates, **please place your offerings for both first and second collections in the marked containers in the foyer.** Changing our mind-set of giving via the plate is difficult, and it is very easy to walk past the collection boxes in the foyer without giving anything. Please be conscious of this because if this happens, we will be in great financial difficulties.
- Offerings for the **first collection** can be placed in the **red first collection box.** Offerings, including planned giving envelopes for the **second collection** can be placed in the **green second collection box** in the church foyer. **Thank you.**
- If you currently given by Planned Giving Envelopes, please consider changing to Direct Debit or Credit Card to ensure the regular income of the parish continues. **Contact the parish office to arrange this.**
- If you are not in the Parish Financial System and would like to join to support the Parish, forms are available at the Foyer Notice Board, or contact the parish office. **Thank you for your support.**
- **If you are not yet coming physically to Mass, please remember to drop your Planned Giving Envelope into the secure letter box at the front entry to the Parish Office each week.** First collection offerings for the sustenance of the clergy can be placed in a plain envelope marked 'First Collection'. **Thank you.**
- The church still cannot be left open during the day at the moment.
